



Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Crossings at Brick Church water quality improvement project in East Orange City, NJDEP Project No. S340843-03 will be financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits necessary and substantial improvements and enhancements to the stormwater and sanitary sewer infrastructure systems (the “Water Facilities”) in the area. The Project includes the demolition of existing building and substandard infrastructure, replacement and rehabilitation of the Water Facilities, implementation of a necessary ground water remediation program and construction of the impervious cap, through appropriate building foundations and asphalt-paved roadways, that will mitigate and prevent any further contamination of the site and the surrounding areas for residents and businesses in the City of East Orange, Essex County, New Jersey.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
