

ORDINANCE NO. ²⁵ OF 2014

AN ORDINANCE AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 5 OF 1975 AND
CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF EAST ORANGE
TO ESTABLISH THE DIRECTOR OF PROPERTY
MAINTENANCE AS THE PUBLIC OFFICER

WHEREAS, the City of East Orange seeks to update its code to establish the
Director of Property Maintenance as the Public Officer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of
East Orange that the code of the City of East Orange is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. (amended section)

**9:1-8 § 159-8. Designation of ~~public officer~~ Public Officer; ~~powers and duties of~~
~~public officer generally~~ Powers and Duties.**

The Director of the ~~Department of Inspection and Licensing~~ Department of
Property Maintenance is hereby designated to serve as the ~~public officer~~ Public Officer
under this ~~section~~ chapter. All inspections, regulations, enforcement and hearings on
violations of the provisions of ~~Chapter 9 of the "Code of the City of East Orange~~ this
chapter , unless expressly stated to the contrary, shall be under his direction and
supervision. He may appoint or designate such other public officials or employees of the
city to perform duties as may be necessary to the enforcement of this chapter, including the
making of inspections and holding of hearings.

SECTION 2. Severability of Ordinance Provisions

Each section of this ordinance is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity of constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

SECTION 3. Conflict of Other Ordinance Provisions

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances and conflicts that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date of Ordinance Provisions

That this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage upon expiration of twenty (20) days following publication unless otherwise provided
